HOW TO PAY

We accept payment by credit or debit cards. Credit and debit card payments can be made over the telephone prior to treatment. To make a credit/debit card payment please telephone the WFI Neath Administration Team on 01639 862698 or via email at <u>admin.wfi@wales.nhs.uk</u>.

You will be provided with a receipt for your payment showing an authorisation code. This will be your proof of payment and the receipt can be emailed or posted to you. Payments by card will show on your statement as WFI Professional Services.

WHEN TO PAY

Payment must be made prior to each appointment. Patients having fertility treatments will need to pay for treatment prior to booking their nurse co-ordination appointment. You can telephone the IVF unit to make appointments and arrange payment.

Treatment cannot commence until all outstanding payments have been settled.

If you are planning to have an additional procedure, you should pay for these at the same time as your treatment payment. If the decision to have these procedures is not made until after your egg collection (e.g conversion from IVF to ICSI), then we ask you to pay on the day of treatment. Patients who are having PGS or PGD will pay the package price for their cycle i.e. ICSI with the



additional cost for the PGS or the PGD at the same time. An embryologist will explain the tests required and the difference between the development and test fees.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF TREATMENT AND PAYMENTS

Private medical insurance companies do not generally cover assisted conception treatments, but you may be covered for some consultation appointments, investigations and surgical procedures. Patients will be required to make payments directly either before or at the time of the appointment or treatment and if appropriate, claim the cost retrospectively from the medical insurance company.

Appointments for all consultations, follow up reviews, scans and blood tests will not be arranged until payment has been made.

Patients having fertility treatments will need to pay for treatment prior to booking their nurse coordination appointment.

Treatment must start no more than three months from the date of your last consultation appointment. If you delay starting your treatment you may incur additional costs as some investigation tests may need to be repeated.

In the event that additional treatments are provided, we expect patients to pay for these prior to or on the day of the treatment. If additional treatments have taken place and no payment is received, we will invoice patients for the outstanding amount and will expect payment to be made within 14 days of the date of the invoice. In the event of payment not being received, following a reminder, we will instruct a debt collection company to commence proceedings to recover the debt. Should this be necessary, debt collection, legal and administration fees and statutory interest will be added to the debt.

An annual storage fee of £305 is required where supernumerary gametes or embryos are frozen (please note for IVF and ICSI treatment the first year of storage is included in the cost of the Treatment Package as shown on page 2). All patients receive a reminder letter up to six months prior to the invoice being issued. All patients are given the option to continue with their storage or to discard their samples.

REFUND INFORMATION

Occasionally, patients choose to delay the start of their treatment or decide not to go ahead with treatment at all. If this happens, then we will make a full refund of any treatment costs that you paid to your original payment card. If you would like to apply for a refund, please contact the Service on <u>wfi.admin@wales.nhs.uk</u>.

Unfortunately, it is sometimes necessary to discontinue treatment for medical reasons, which can be due to poor or excessive response to the treatment drugs, or a co-incidental development of another condition during the treatment. Depending on the stage of treatment at cancellation, a partial refund may be due.

Refunds will be made to the debit or credit card that your original payment was made with. Full details of the cancellation fees per treatment type are outlined in the table below. The cancellation fee is currently £350.

We cannot make any refunds for:

- The cost of pre-treatment investigations.
- The cost of drugs for any treatment cycle.
- The cost of donor sperm.
- PGD & PGS Development costs for PGD are paid upfront and there is no refund for this. If embryos or eggs are biopsied then you are liable for the biopsy fee. If genetic analysis is performed then you are liable for the PGS or PGD fee. Occasionally analysis fails,



contamination occurs or there are no normal embryos to transfer. There is no refund in this situation.

Please note: If you are having an IVF or ICSI cycle and your embryo transfer is cancelled because you are at risk of hyperstimulation syndrome (OHSS), your embryos will be frozen and you will be offered a frozen cycle (FET) once you have recovered from the OHSS at a reduced cost of £750. Any subsequent FET's will be chargeable at the full cost of £1475.
